## **Universal Mount ATV/UTV Wheel Chock (TX211)**



YUTRAX™ offers a full line of Engineered Outdoor Gear. We appreciate your purchase of one of our world class ATV/UTV Wheel Chocks. Follow these few simple instructions and your product will be sure to give you many years of trouble free pleasure. Instructions should be kept in a safe place and reviewed at least annually.

### **ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS:**

Tools needed -- two 7/16" wrenches and two 1/2" wrenches.

NOTE: This ATV/UTV Wheel Chock was universally designed to work on most brands of ATV/UTV's.

- Insert (2) lower wheel chock tubes (68100) into the upper wheel chock tube (68099) by inserting swedged end of lower tubes into the upper tube. Be sure both lower tubes are inserted the same direction. SEE PARTS EXPLOSION.
- With both lower tubes inserted into the upper tube, secure them together using (2) provided 1/4-20 x 1-1/2" bolts and locknuts. SEE PARTS EXPLOSION. Make sure the head of the bolts are on the inside of wheel chock so threaded end of the bolts will not interfere with wheel of vehicle when in use. Tighten securely.
- 3. Attach (2) channel mounts (68098) to each lower tube using (2) provided spring lock pins. Make sure channels are oriented as per the PARTS EXPLOSION. Spring lock pins should be orientated so heads are to the inside of wheel chock, and latch ends are to the outside of wheel chock. SEE PARTS EXPLOSION. Place the assembled wheel chock with channels attached onto the bed of hauling vehicle (trailer). With the wheel chock in the desired location, mark the 4 locations to drill holes for permanent attachment of the channels. Remove wheel chock after hole locations are marked.
- 4. Using a 21/64" drill bit, drill the four marked locations in bed of hauling vehicle (trailer). Use caution and be sure you are not going to drill through any critical structure point of hauling vehicle (trailer).
- Attach the channel mounts to the bed of hauling vehicle (trailer) using (4) provided 5/16-18 x 1-1/4" or 5/16-18 x 1-3/4" or 5/16-18 x 2-1/4" bolts, locknuts and fender washers. SEE PARTS EXPLOSION. Tighten Securely.

### NOTE: Bolt length is dependant upon thickness of your trailer bed.

6. Wheel chock can now be attached and detached easily by using the spring lock pins. Be sure spring lock pins are latched to prevent accidental removal. Channel mounts are designed to be permanently attached to bed of hauling vehicle (trailer).

USE CAUTION WHEN DRIVING INTO WHEEL CHOCK TO PREVENT UNNECESSARY DAMAGE.


VEHICLE SHOULD ALWAYS BE TIED FORWARD TO APPLY PRESSURE ON WHEEL CHOCK.


